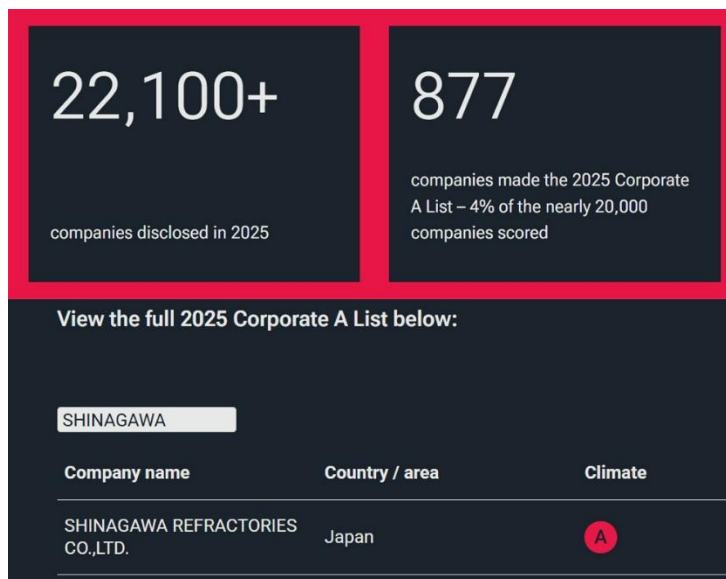

SHINAGAWA REFRA's inclusion on the Corporate A List underscores the company's strong commitment to sustainability across its global operations, including continuous efforts to reduce environmental impact, improve energy efficiency, and support customers in achieving their own decarbonization goals through advanced refractory and materials technologies.
